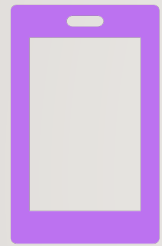

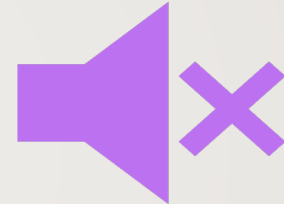

# MORE ON VIRTUAL TRAINING SET UP

- Know your learning platform, if not, partner with a colleague
- Do not put session links online! Send separately via email upon registration
- Log on half an hour early for set up. Check sound, video, presentation mode, video background
- Accessibility - enable captioning, consider transcription services or sign language interpretation
- Ask participants to ensure their name is correct
